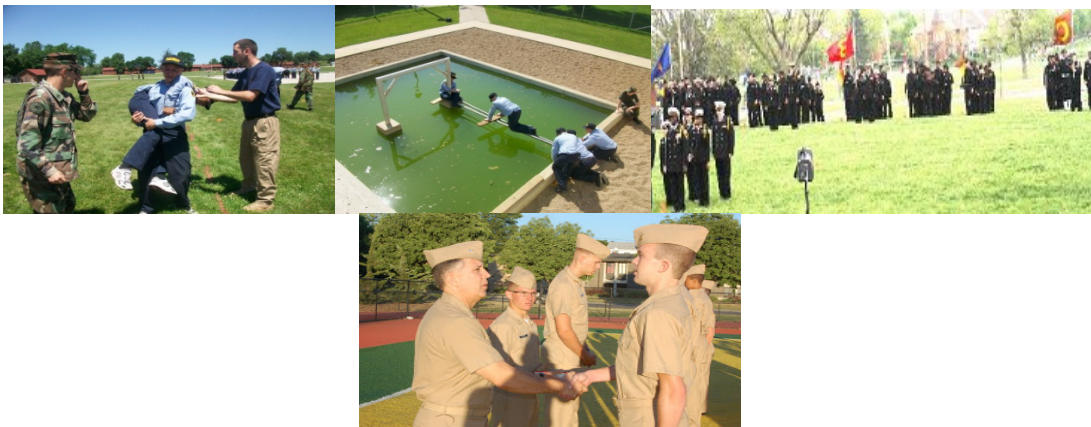
Our Sea Cadet and League Cadet programs (Battleship Missouri Division) have almost 100 cadets. We fund their two week summer trainings throughout the United States at Military bases and many other events. The U.S. Naval Sea Cadet Corps is a non-profit youth program for Americans ages 11 through 18. They are composed of more than 380 units in 48 states, Guam and Puerto Rico. They provide compelling, life-changing programs that instill the values of teamwork, discipline, camaraderie and service through our passionate all-volunteer force and their partnerships with our nation's armed forces. www.seacadetsbmd.org and www.seacadets.org

We also sponsor and support NJROTC Washington (100 cadets), NJROTC Cleveland (360 cadets), NJROTC Riverview Gardens (430 cadets), MCJROTC Roosevelt (200 cadets), and MCJROTC Pacific (250 cadets). Our support ranges from funding them to attend drill and rifle competitions to attending the Naval Ball. The ages of these students are from 13-18.

What does the NJROTC program do? JROTC promotes patriotism, develops informed and responsible citizens, develops respect for constructed authority, develops leadership potential, promotes high school completion, promotes higher education, promotes community service, develops a high degree of personal honor, self-reliance, individual discipline and leadership, promotes an understanding of the basic elements and need for national security, provides information on the military services as a possible career, provides an alternative to gangs, and provides incentive to live healthy and drug free.
